WBC International Bantamweight and Silver Superflyweight Championships

Mexican promoter Bobby Quitarte has postponed two Championships which he was ready to stage next April 14th in México. The new date looks to be May 18th.

Bantamweight champion Alejandro Santiago Barrios was supposed to defend his title against Willibaldo Garcia Perez (México).

vacant WBC International 108 Lbs Championship - Lightfly weight -

Due to the corona virus outbreak and the strict instructions circulated by the Jakarta Provincial Authorities, Armin Tan Promotions decided to postpone the WBC International light flyweight title bout from March 20th to **April 25th**.

It is now well known that the spread of corona virus in Asia and around the world has been causing several dates to be suddenly postponed. Armin Tan reported that Jakarta Provincial Government has suspended the issuing of permits to organize sporting events in the province. Therefore, the vacant championship between world rated contenders **Tibo Monabesa and Toto Landero** is now postponed to next April 25th in Jakarta (Indonesia).

WBC International Lightweight champion **Viktor Kotochigov** was planning to make a voluntary defence next March 22nd in Almaty (Kazakhstan). An infection suffered by the champion will cause the fight to be postponed (April/May). More to come.

WBC International Minimum weight vacant Championship

The fight for the vacant WBC International 105 Lbs crown could take place in Panama soon.

Ali Akhmedov relinquished the WBC International 168Lbs Silver title in order to concentrate his efforts on a fight for the vacant regular crown. Tom Loeffler has reported that the date of the vacant Championship could be next June 6th at the Forum in Los Angeles. More to come.

WBC International Lightweight champion **Viktor Kotochigov** was planning to make a voluntary defence on March 22nd in Almaty (Kazakhstan). An infection suffered by the champion will cause the fight to be postponed (April/May). More to come.

WBC International Flyweight Silver champion **Sebastiàn Gomez Sànchez** was supposed to defend his belt against David Martinez (México) next March 28th in Cd. De Teopisca Estado de Chiapas (México). Ing. Saúl Andrade Rivero informed that , due to an indisposition suddenly suffered by the reigning champion, the championship will be postponed to a later date. The new date most likely in May.

The WBC International 130 Lbs Silver title is now vacant. Former champion Michael Magnesi has relinquished it. The WBC International 118 Lbs Silver title is now vacant. Narek Abgaryan is now the champion anymore having failed to make a title defence.

Amir Khan reported he was keen to defend his WBC International Welterweight title in Saudi Arabia (April/May). Final confirmation depending on the corona virus outbreak.

Filip Hrgovic is next scheduled to fight on April 17 at the MGM National Harbour in Maryland. This event will be broadcasted globally by DAZN. The champion will defend his WBC International Heavyweight title against Jerry Forrest (USA). Final confirmation depending on the corona virus outbreak.

The Committee is keen to support promoter Alexander Popov (Patriot Promotions Company) for a show in Sochi (Russia) next April 25th. The show will see Olympic Bronze medal Rustam Tulaganov (Uzbekistan) to fight for the now **vacant WBC International 175Lbs Silver** belt against TBA.
