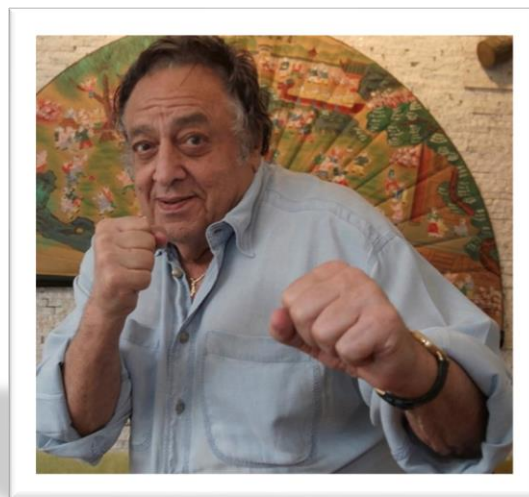

After a very successful WBC Annual Convention we held at the Presidente Hotel in México City, we are now reporting the most significant results about our WBC International title

Zhan Kossobutskiy (Kazakhstan) remained unbeaten after he stopped in five rounds Alexis Garcia (Dominican Republic) last Saturday November 20th in Hamburg to win the vacant WBC International Heavyweight Silver title. The Dominican fighter suffered his first pro defeat. Garcia still on his feet when referee Daniel Van De Wiele decided that enough was enough. The new champ is now the mandatory challenger to Martin Bakole.

Dean Sutherland stopped in eight well fought rounds Italy's Michele Esposito to win the vacant WBC International Silver Welter weight title. Time of the stoppage 1'57"

November 5th 2021 - Ulster Hall in Belfast, Northern Ireland

Unbeaten Pdraig "The Hammer" McCrory successfully defended his WBC International 168lbs Silver belt with a second round KO over Celso Neves (Portugal, licensed in Switzerland).

McCrory dropped Neves twice in round two and Ian John-Lewis stopped the fight after 35 secs of that session.

Apparently, Neves won the first round catching the home favourite with some good shots during the opening three minutes.

So, looking a good start for Neves, who went to Belfast to fight and win.

Eventually, McCrory's power made the difference.

The champion improved to 13-0 with seven Kos.

Youssef Khoumari *lost by MD 10 to* Jorge David Castañeda – For the vacant WBC International Silver super-featherweight title -

BOUT: Our WBC International Silver Championship turned out to be the best fight of the night, indeed. The two contenders expressed their entertaining boxing, produced by different styles. The Englishman (Khoumari) started cautiously, leaving the first session to the American. He then did very well in the next four rounds thanks to a better effectiveness and precision of his shots, against the higher pace shown by the American. Castañeda's aggression increased in the following two rounds, supported, albeit by measure, by the greater number of blows on target. In the eighth round, thanks to a good left hook visibly accused by Khoumari, the visitor managed to place the scoring in a perfect equality. Aware of having shaken his opponent, the Texan continued the attacking actions during the final six minutes, managing to win our belt, which was the only one at stake. The final result was a majority victory for

Castañeda as one judge finally had 95-95. The other two judges had 97-94 and 96-94 for Castañeda who is now the new WBC International Silver champion at Super Featherweight.

Huge upset in London on October 29th as WBC International SWweight champion Tursynbay Kulakhmet (Kazakhstan - Wbc #18) lost his title by KO to Juan Carlos Abreu (Dominican Republic). The southpaw champion had things initially going well as he dropped Abreu after 1'51" of round two. But, the Dominican visitor had no intention to show a white flag and recovered well. Round four was well fought by both contenders, with Abreu who suffered a little cut from an accidental headbutt.

In round seven Abreu dropped the champion after one minute. A very clean knockdown, with the champion beating the count but still in trouble. The end came at 1'32" of round seven with Abreu dropping again Kulakhmet face first. Referee Victor Loughlin did not start the count and ruled it as a KO.

The fight was promoted by MTK GLOBAL at the York Hall in London.



Isaac Lowe will fight an IBF Eliminator next December 3rd in London.

The WBC International Feather weight crown has been declared vacant.

The Committee will soon announce the vacant title bout.

The WBA has announced that current WBC International 140lbs champion Ohara Davies will fight Ismael Barroso next 26th November in Dubai for their belt.

The WBC International crown has now been declared vacant.

Interested promoters are asked to send their proposals.

WBC International former champion **Ralfs Vilcans** (Latvia) was stripped of his title and suspended for six months after he was tested positive in a "out-of-competition" control (October 4, 2021).

Super-bantamweight **Liam Davies** (UK) is now 11-0 after he outpointed in a ten-round vacant WBC International 122lbs Silver championship Dixon Flores of Nicaragua. The Championship was promoted by Queensberry in Birmingham last October 9th.

Ryan Rozicki (Nova Scotia, Canada - WBC #18) fought against Oscar Rivas (Colombia) last October 22nd at the Olympia Theatre in Montreal (Québec) for the vacant WBC World Bridgerweight title and lost on points after a very brave and good performance. The WBC International Cruiserweight Silver title has been declared vacant.

Elvin Ganbarov –

The WBC International SuperWelter weight Silver title was declared vacant - Ganbarov fought last September 10 in Atlanta against Albert Mensah at super Welter for the so-called Naba-Wba belt without a WBC certification.

Great action fight in Hamburg and dramatic end as young Samuel Molina (Spain), previously unbeaten, staggered Artem Harutyunyan (Armenia-Germany) in the fourth and the fifth but could not get the KO. Seconds later in the fifth, local fighter Artem landed a perfect left hook to the chin to KO Molina at 2:31 of that session. Artem won the vacant WBC International Lightweight title (KO5).
