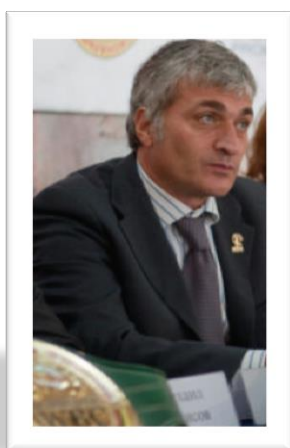

Chris Kongo lost by MD12 to Ekow Essuman last January 21st in Manchester. It was previously agreed that our champion would not fight for Essuman's IBF regional belt, only for our title and British and Commonwealth , instead. Essuman is the new champion, but he cannot be rated by the WBC due to his IBF Europe belt.

Superlight **Pierce O'Leary** (Ireland)

Pierce will defend his belt next May 27 in Belfast against Alin Florin Cioceri

Silver champion **Henry Turner** (UK)

Henry Turner on his way to defend his Silver belt again next June 9th at the York Hall in London against Tom Farrell. Queensberry will promote.

Light weight **Artem Arutyunyan** (Armenia-Germany)

Artem will defend his belt against top rated Frank Martin in the States next June (Tom Braown promoting)

Silver champion **Sam Noakes** (UK)

Sam Noakes retained his Silver belt last April 15th at the CopperBox in London with a stoppage in round two against India's Karthik Sathish Kumar . Queensberry promoted.

Superfeather **title vacant**

Jadier Herrera Montero (Cuba) lost his title on the scale when he could not make the limit for his title defence of May 13th in Dubai against Jeff Ofori (UK). The interested parties had decided to proceed with the championship, although it was clarified that the vacant belt could only be for Ofori in case he would have defeated Herrera. But, the latter won the fight by TKO4 and the title has now been definitively declared vacant.
