Heavyweight

title vacant

Joseph Parker (New Zealand) won the title of another organization in Riyadh last March 8th .
The WBC International title has been declared vacant.

Silver champion

(France)

Aliev retained his title last May 11th in Köln (Germany) when he stopped in three dominating rounds Montenegro's Dilan Prasovic. Championship promoted by Universum.

Bridgerweight

Former world champion Danny Green will stage the vacant championship in Darling Harbour (Sydney, Australia) - Kris Terzievski vs Tyson Pedro - The latter suffered a hand injury and the championship is now in jeopardy. It will most likely need to be widely postponed.

Lightheavy **William Hutchinson** (Scotland)

Hutchinson retained his title last March 22nd in a show promoted by Queensberry at the York Hall in London (UK). Willy stopped in two rounds Germany's Martin Houben

Silver title **Branimir Malenica** (Germany)

Branimir Malenica stopped in round five Ahmed Dananovic to win this vacant title last January 27th in Köln (Germany)

Supermiddle **Luka Plantic** (Croatia)

Luka Plantic stopped in five tough rounds UK's Jack Cullen last April 6th to win the vacant WBC International title. Aschaffenburg (Germany) by Ahmet Öner of Arena Box Promotions.

Silver champion **Serhat Güler** (Turkey)

Serhat won a non-title bout last May 11th in Köln (Germany). His title defence next September.

Middleweight **Aaron McKenna** (Ireland)

McKenna was to make a voluntary defence of his crown on January 20th in Liverpool against Nigeria's Linus Udofia (based in UK). BOXXER of Ben Shalom was to promote the championship. Unfortunately, the challenger was unwell and could not box on that date. So, the contest has been postponed to a later date.

Silver title **Samuel Nmomah** (Nigeria)

Samuel will defend his title next July 14 in Sequals (North of Italy). The promoter will be Italy's Mario Loreni.

Superwelterweight **Ermal Hadribeaj** (Albania)

Last January 27th in Köln (Germany) Ermal made another successful title defence by outpointing young unbeaten Bohdan Shtonda (Ukraine) to retain his title. Ermal moved to 18-0, 7. The champion was scheduled to defend his title again next May 11th in Köln (Germany) but a hand injury caused this title defence to be moved to next summer.

Silver champion **Michael McKinson** (UK)

Superlight **Pierce O'Leary** (Ireland)

Pierce O'Leary stopped previously unbeaten Hovhannes Martirosyan (Belgium) last March 16th in Birmingham (UK). The stoppage is the eight in Pierce's career up to date (14-0, 8). Queensberry of Frank Warren promoted.

Silver champion **Henry Turner** (UK)

Turner retained his title last April 20th in London when he stopped inside five rounds Colombia's Maykol Mendoza.

Light weight **Antonio Perez** (USA)

Antonio Perez was supposed to make a title defence on April 27th in Miami, but the fight was finally called off due to the unavailability of the challenger and a little injury in training suffered by the champion. Perez is now definitively scheduled to make his voluntary title defence next June 7 in Hollywood (Florida, US) against Antonio Williams. DKP will promote.

Silver champion vacant

Sam Noakes won the vacant EBU title last April 20 in London when he outpointed Yvan Mendy. Sam's International Silver title has been declared vacant.

Superfeather **Ryan Garner** (UK)

Ryan retained his belt last May 11 in London when he outpointed Liam Dillon

Silver champion Samir Ziani (France)

Samir Ziani retained his Silver belt last April 27th in Marseille when he clearly outpointed former French amateur star Jordan Rodriguez .

Featherweight **Luca Rigoldi** (Italy)

Luca Rigoldi will defend his crown next June 28th against unbeaten Davide Tassi
