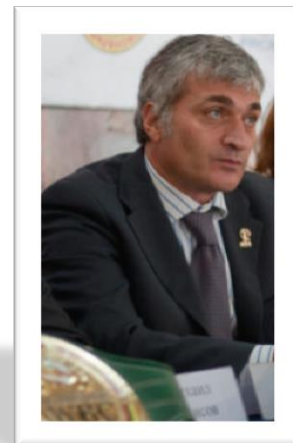

Aliev retained his title last May 11th in Köln (Germany) when he stopped in three dominating rounds Montenegro's Dilan Prasovic.

Yamil Alberto Peralta outscored Thabiso Mchunu in South Africa last March 22nd to win the WBC World Silver title. The vacant WBC International championship was to be held on June 28th in Magdeburg, Germany, promoted by SES Sport Events Steinforth GmbH: Roman Fress vs Yasin Basar.

Yusuf Sultanoglu

(Germany-Turkey)

Yusuf Sultanoglu won the vacant title by TKO'ng Rashad Karimov (Azerbaijan) last June 22 in München.

The loser was leading on points at the end of the fourth round when Sultanoglu sent him to the canvas three times in round five. Although Karimov beat the counts and was on his feet, the referee correctly stopped the fight at the two minutes of round five (TKO5).

Lightheavy**Ezra Taylor** (UK)

Ezra Taylor won the vacant WBC International Lightheavy weight title when he outpointed Spain's Carlos Alberto Lamela last July 20th in Birmingham.

Branimir Malenica (Germany)

Supermiddle**Luka Plantic** (Croatia)

Luka Plantic stopped in five tough rounds UK's Jack Cullen last April 6th to win the vacant WBC International title. Aschaffenburg (Germany) by Ahmet Öner of Arena Box Promotions.

Serhat Güler (Turkey)

Serhat won a non-title bout last May 11th in Köln (Germany). His title defence next September.

Middleweight

Aaron McKenna had won the vacant title last year (June 2023) and never made a single title defence in more than one year.

Samuel Nmomah (Nigeria)

Samuel retained his title last July 14 in Sequals (North of Italy) by outpointing Ukraine's Oleksandr Shyiti.

Superwelterweight**Ermal Hadribeaj** (Albania)

Last January 27th in Köln (Germany) Ermal made another successful title defence by outpointing young unbeaten Bohdan Shtonda (Ukraine) to retain his title. Ermal moved to 18-0, 7. The champion was scheduled to defend his title again next May 11th in Köln (Germany) but a hand injury caused this title defence to be moved to next summer. Ermal is fully recovering from the injury.

Sandy Messaoud (France) outpointed Dorian Maidana (Argentina) last June 15 near Toulouse (France) to win the vacant crown.

Pierce O'Leary retained his title with a good point win last June 28th in Belfast against Darragh Foley.

Henry Turner (UK)

Turner retained his title last April 20th in London when he stopped inside five rounds Colombia's Maykol Mendoza.

Light weight **Antonio Perez** (USA)

Antonio Perez retained his crown last June 7 in Hollywood (Florida, US) outpointing previously unbeaten Antonio Williams. DKP promoted.

Silver champion Yosdiel Napoles (Cuba)

Yosdiel Napoles stopped Wister Garcia last June 7th in Miami to win this vacant belt.

Superfeather **Ryan Garner** (UK)

Ryan, after retaining his belt last May 11 against Liam Dillon, will make another title defence next July 27th in London against unbeaten Archie Sharp. Queensberry will promote.

Silver champion Samir Ziani (France)

Samir Ziani retained his Silver belt last April 27th in Marseille when he clearly outpointed former French amateur star Jordan Rodriguez .

Featherweight **Luca Rigoldi** (Italy)

Luca Rigoldi retained his crown last June 28th with a TD9 win against unbeaten Davide Tassi

Silver champion Wira Mikham (Thailand)

This vacant title bout was held last 10th June in Bangkok (Thailand).

Wira Mikham stopped in eight rounds Daisuke Sugita to win the vacant silver belt.

Superbantam **title vacant**

Liam Davies (UK) won the title of another organization last March 16th and the International belt has been vacated.
